PRINCIPAL'S ADDRESS

Blue card changes are coming from 20 September.

From 20th September, there are changes to the Blue Card legislation that will affect parents.

Parent volunteers will require blue cards if:

- Parent volunteering does not include their own child
- Parents attend overnight excursions or camps
- close personal contact may occur with another child (such as assisting with toileting, bathing or dressing).

External businesses providing services in schools or to children will now need a blue card.



If you want to attend a camp, or volunteer at school in areas such as uniform shop or tuckshop, you might want to consider getting a Volunteer Blue Card. CASUAL POSITION VACANT

A casual position exists for a School Crossing Supervisor at Withcott State School.

The hours of work for the School Crossing Supervisor may be up to an Hour and a Half on any school day in all weather conditions.

Commencement of work for the successful applicant is dependent on:

- The favourable outcome of a health assessment carried out by a duly qualified Medical Practitioner according to the guidelines in the "Notes for Medical Practitioner" on the School Crossing Supervisor Scheme - Health Assessment
- The applicant either must hold a current Blue Card or be eligible to submit an application for a Blue Card to the Commission for Blue Card Services. An applicant will not be employed by the Department of Transport and Main Roads unless they meet this criterion.

Department of Transport of Main Roads will organise and fund both Medical and Blue Card for selected applicant.




